RELICS VISIT ARMIDALE

The Cathedral Parish of Armidale is honoured to exhibit the relics of Saint Thérèse of Lisieux, and those of her parents, Saints Louis and Zélie Martin, on Thursday 20th February with the following program:

Saint Thérèse of Lisieux is one of the most popular saints of the modern era. Born in France in 1873, she entered a Catholic convent after personally beseeching the Pope to allow her to become a nun at the unusually young age of 15. She is endeared for her dedication to “small acts” of charity and love and is popularly known as “The Little Flower of Jesus”. In 1925, she was canonised at the Vatican’s Saint Peter’s Basilica, in a ceremony attended by over 600,000 supporters. Thérèse of Lisieux is the *patron saint* of missions, aviators, illnesses and florists.

Her parents, Louis and Zélie, became the first spouses to be canonised as a couple in 2015. They are recognised for living remarkable lives of devotion, austerity and charity.

The tour provides a rare opportunity to visit the relics for veneration and reflection.

The relics will also be hosted at Tenterfield, Inverell, Moree and Tamworth. For a full itinerary of each venue please visit <https://www.catholicmission.org.au/relics>
