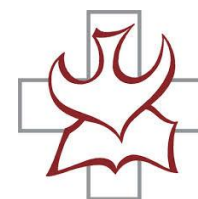

### HOLY COMMUNION TO THE SICK AND HOUSEBOUND

The limited number of Extra-ordinary ministers of Holy Communion, the celebration of Sunday Masses and Baptisms and pastoral visits to sick, together with the increasing number of parishioners seeking to have Holy Communion at home means changes have to be made to the current practice. Holy Communion will now be taken by ministers to the SICK AND HOUSEBOUND fortnightly as from Corpus Christi - next weekend. Parishioners who normally attend a Sunday Mass but for a short time due to illness and/or disability are unable to do so will have first priority. It is anticipated that following recuperation they will return to Sunday Mass.

Other parishioners according to available human resources may receive Holy Communion during the week. Nursing Homes at this stage remain unaffected. If parishioners are able to go to the cinema, the pub, dine at the club, shop, have hair done down town, attend weekday Mass, they are illegible for Holy Communion at home which is for the sick and the housebound. Parishioners registering at the parish office for Holy Communion outside of Mass for the first time must be visited by a priest before the extraordinary ministry can begin. Only the sick or housebound parishioner themselves (or a legally authorised carer) can request Holy Communion outside of Mass.
