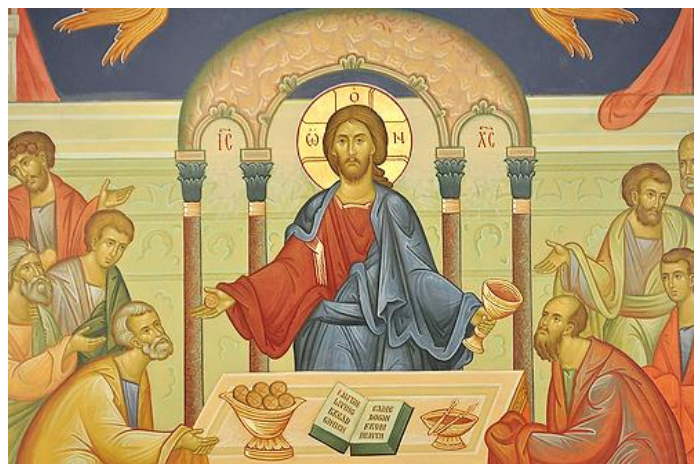

Let's talk about our Faith

What are Sacraments?

From all eternity, God the Father has been invisible, but audible. At the appointed time, He made Himself visible in the Son who is the Icon of the Father. Thus, "the God who has Spoken" (Karl Barth), spoke the Word, who in the Spirit became flesh and dwell among us. The Invisible is revealed by the Word spoken in the Spirit.

Christ therefore is the Sacrament of the Father; He reveals the invisible God (Colossians 1:15). The Church in turn is the Sacrament of the Son. After the Ascension into heaven, Christ who became invisible, continues to reveal Himself in and through the Church. Thus, whenever the Church celebrates the Sacraments, Christ is present.

When Christ is present, the whole Godhead is at work. Hence, "Sacraments are 'powers that comes forth' from the Body of Christ, which is ever-living and life-giving" (CCC. 1116). They are outward signs or acts that convey the invisible reality, instituted by Jesus Christ by which grace is given to both the celebrant and the participants.
