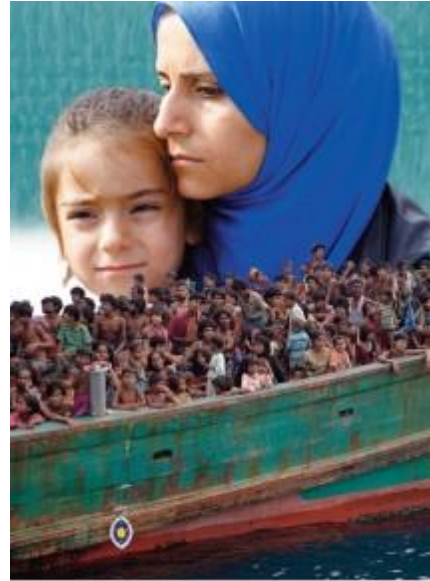

**Refugees... The Australian Catholic Bishop Conference is telling us to hold off from taking action until more information is available from the Government. The Government is indicating they want to put clusters of refugees in areas where they can be totally supported as they will have complex needs and will need constant ongoing professional support. The Chancery will be sending out a survey to parishes and schools asking what support their communities can provide. This will be fed back into the ACBC data base for review. The Diocese is working with Catholic and Government agencies to determine what support we can offer to the Syrian refugees. More information will be available in coming weeks.**
