## How Many Sacraments are there?

Christ instituted the sacraments of the new law. There are seven: **Baptism, Confirmation** (or **Chrismation**), **the Eucharist, Penance, the Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders and Matrimony** (Sacrament of Marriage). The seven sacraments touch all the stages and all the important moments of Christian life: they give birth and increase, healing and mission to the Christian's life of faith. There is thus a certain resemblance between the stages of natural life and the stages of the Spiritual life (CCC 1210).
