The Sacramentality of Time

In a way, we can look at keeping holy the Sabbath (as well as other ascetical practices of rest and presence) not only as a moral obligation and one of the Ten Commandments, but also as a form of non-violent protest against the "tyranny of the urgent." In his book *Sabbath as Resistance*, Walter Brueggemann claims that to keep holy the Sabbath is a form of resistance to anxiety, coercion, exclusivism, and multitasking.^[22] We could add to this list: ministerial burnout, the glorification of busy, etc. By intentionally adopting ascetical practices that reorient our behaviours toward time, we put into practice our trust that 1) God gives us everything we need to carry out his mission, including enough time, and 2) that God is revealing himself to us, that he is concretely present with us, in that time. And this leads us into our liturgical lens.
