

## CHANGES TO MASS SCHEDULE...

Please take note of the Mass schedule this week. Now that 50 people can be in the Cathedral at one time, the weekday Masses have been reduced to two per day except for Wednesday when there is also a Latin Mass in Our Lady of the Angels Chapel at 7am. Sunday Masses will continue as of last weekend with two Masses at each timeslot. There has also been a change to the confession time on Saturday afternoon 4 to 5pm.

## DIACONAL ORDINATION – DAMIEN LOCKE

Next week on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June Damien Locke will be ordained Deacon. Due to the COVID 19 restrictions the ordination will take place in the chapel of the Beda College and not in the Basilica as is usually the case for the ordinations of seminarians from the Beda.

Due to international travel restrictions in Australia, Damien will not return for his pastoral placement. He may be able to undertake a pastoral placement in his former parish of St Francis of Assisi, Jebel Ali in Dubai UAE instead if restrictions allow.

Please keep Damien in your prayers as he prepares for ordination and incardination into the Diocese of Armidale.

## CURRENT COVID-19 RULES FOR WORSHIP

Weekday and Sunday Masses have resumed with **NO BOOKING REQUIRED**. The Sunday Masses will be at the usual times however, there will be two Masses at each time – in the Cathedral and Our Lady of the Angels Chapel. Please note the following:

**A MAXIMUM OF 50 WORSHIPPERS** are allowed in the church at any one time for **MASSES, FUNERALS, BAPTISMS AND RELIGIOUS SERVICES**.

- **EXCEPT WEDDINGS** where a maximum of 20 attendees plus the couple, celebrant and assisting ministers, organist and singer can be present.
- **SIGN IN** when entering the Church.
- **Please MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING with:**
  - 4 square metres per person **and**
  - 1.5 metres between each person.
- **AT RISK PERSONS** should not attend Mass or come to other services.
- **DURING MASS THERE WILL BE NO:**
  - Procession of gifts
  - Sign of Peace
  - Congregational singing
  - Use of hymn books or shared missals or prayer cards
  - passing of collection plates – baskets for each of the 1st (blue bag) and 2nd (red bag) collections in front of the sanctuary. All donations are gratefully accepted.
- **BULLETINS ARE SINGLE USE** – take this home with you or put in the bin. Do not leave it in the church.
- **HAND SANITISER** is available for your use as you enter and leave the Church.
- **SURFACES ARE DISINFECTED AFTER EACH MASS.**
- **MARKED SEATS: FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS**
