FAMILY PRAYER

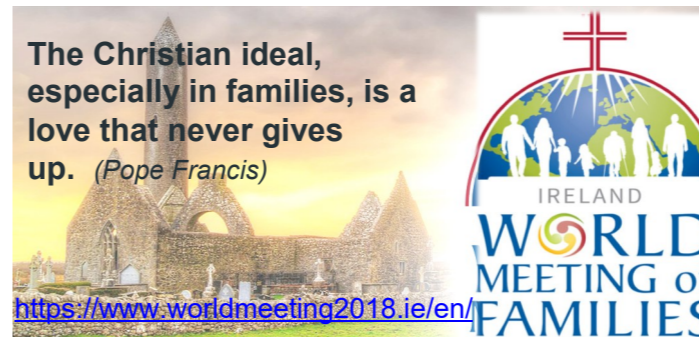

Parish Stewardship Program: Week 4:

This weekend we complete **Phase One** of the Stewardship Program. In this phase, at weekend Masses, we have presented information about the **TIME, TALENT AND TREASURE** aspects of the Program in support of the parish and sought formal Commitments from parishioners.

The Stewardship Committee is most grateful to have received 67 Commitment and Parish Registration forms. 55 parishioners have committed to giving of their **TALENTS** and **TIME** to ensure the Liturgical and Parish tasks are able to be effectively carried out.

The Stewardship Committee is also appreciative of parishioners' generous giving from personal financial resources, **TREASURE**, to enable the Finance Committee to set a realistic budget.

Being aware that we have not yet reached many members of St Patrick's Parish, **Phase Two** will be conducted over the next few weeks through a 'mail-out' to those members, inviting them to be actively involved in the three aspects of the Stewardship Program. Commitment materials will be included in the 'mail-out' so that the Commitment sheets can be posted back to the parish or placed on the second-collection plate during coming weeks.

Commitment sheets are still available at each of the church doors and these, too, can be posted or placed on the second-collection plate each week.
