FIRST HOLY COMMUNION *Catechesis* has begun after the 8.30am Mass on Sunday candidates are required to attend the brief Sessions with Fr Gleeson after Mass. The overall program entails: Religious Instruction in School at St Joseph's; Units of work for Parents and their child at home; and *Catechesis* with Fr Gleeson where the emphasis is *believing and living* the Catholic faith in the Eucharist. **FIRST HOLY COMMUNION is of course a Sacrament of Membership in the Church and so requires outward witness to membership of the Body of Christ the Church.**
