The Catholic School Advisory Council provides the opportunity for members of the school and parish community to support the mission of Catholic education in the school. Working with the Principal and the Parish Priest, the members of the Council and its committees provide guidance and support to the wider school community.

• **3.1 Catholic School Advisory Councils** have been approved by the Bishop for the service of the Church and the Catholic school communities in the Diocese of Armidale.

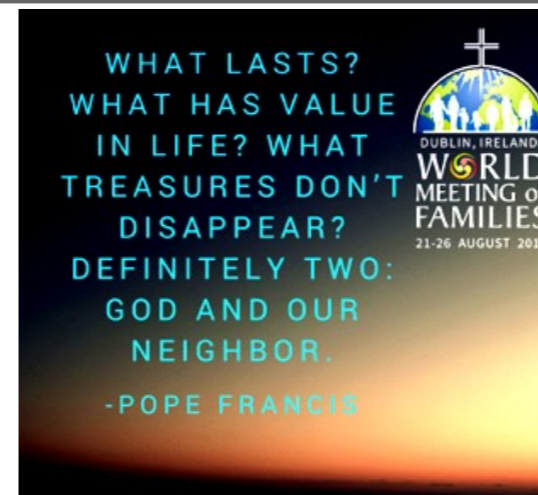
• **3.2 The Constitution** is issued by the Bishop's Commission for Catholic Schools, Diocese of Armidale, with the authority of the Bishop.
