

STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM – WEEK 2

Last Sunday, John Adams, the Chair of the Stewardship Committee, gave an outline of the **Stewardship Program**, seeking commitment from parishioners to giving of their talents to assist parish development in ministry, to assist the parish to be a vibrant and forward-thinking entity and a commitment to the financial budget for the coming year.

Commitment forms were available for parishioners to fill in at Mass or to take home for completion and return at Masses this Sunday. Collection baskets are stationed at each main door of the church where completed forms can be deposited.

Those who were away from Glen Innes last week, can take a form from the bundles at the end of each pew, complete it at this Mass for collection or take home to consider the various **Talent** tasks listed and apply their name to those activities with which they are comfortable.

The **Parish Registration** section of the form is important to enable the Parish to collate an up-to-date list of our parishioners, their families and their contact details.

Giving from one's personal finances (**Treasure**) according to ability can be indicated by completing the section which details the amount that can be given, the frequency of the giving and using either the Envelopes of the program or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). There is a sheet providing the banking details for EFT. This sheet can be completed and taken to parishioners' bank and having the request executed by that bank.

Completed Stewardship forms can be return at the weekend Masses of 14th/15th July.
