SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN & the VULNERABLE
in our Parish of St Patrick's Glen Innes NSW

All individuals, groups, volunteers, lay ministries etc who are in anyway associated with children in our Parish Community on a regular basis **MUST LODGE WITH THE PARISH OFFICE A VALID COPY OF THEIR WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK.**

They **MUST HAVE READ THE DIOCESAN POLICY AND GUIDELINES** for **BUILDING A SAFE PARISH FOR CHILDREN AND THE VULNERABLE.**

They must have completed the minimal Professional Standards training with the properly appointed Parish Priest and have documentary certification that they have read the relevant Professional standards documents etc....**INTEGRITY IN THE SERVICE OF THE CHURCH.**

Ministries in the Parish MUST COMPLY with the parish protocols laid down by the properly appointed parish priest. Records of Ministry, time place and nature of visitation etc must be lodged with the Parish Office as soon as possible.

It is fine if one *cannot comply* with the requirements. There is no shame in handing in your resignation. But Professional Standards **MUST** be complied with, and regular auditing of parishes and the Diocese by Catholic Professional Standards Limited have already commenced in Australia. Please see:
