**PARENTS SEEKING BAPTISM OF INFANTS OF CHILDREN** should make an appointment with the Administrator. There will need to be a preparatory meeting. Parents are reminded that a sponsor who has been fully initiated into the Catholic Church (baptism, confirmation, Holy Communion) and is over 16 years of age is required ... validly baptised members of other Christian Churches may act as Christian witnesses but only two names can be record in the register. Baptism certificates of sponsors may be required. Parent must present a copy of the birth certificate of their child to the Administrator.
