This year Australia Day falls on a Sunday ...next Sunday 26 January. It is this coincidence of day and date that the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference is using as an opportunity for Catholics in parishes across Australia to make a unifying effort to assist our fellow Australians impacted by the unprecedented fire events across our country. We acknowledge that many of our parish members will have already made very generous donations towards one or more of the many appeals being conducted by so many organisations and individuals since the fires began. This includes the donations received by Vinnies locally to use in support of people affected by the fires in Torrington and Wyaliba.
