What's been happening with the Plenary Council submissions? Submissions to the Plenary Council closed on 13 March 2019, and National Centre for Pastoral Research staff have begun the process of analysis. We received over 10,000 submissions in February and March alone, with the final total number of submissions being 17,457 which represented over 222,000 individuals. The final report providing a summary of submissions will be released soon and a media release about the report is available at <https://mediablog.catholic.org.au/plenary-council-is-listening-to-222000-voices/>. The final themes that have emerged from the Listening and Dialogue process will be released on 9 June.
