Pastoral Care of the Sick: Parishioners who would like a Priest to visit them in hospital or in a Nursing home, or at home should contact the Presbytery and make a request. Only the person themselves or an authorised person can ask a Priest to attend someone who is in hospital. As lists are not supplied, the only way a Priest knows someone is in hospital is for the person themselves or an authorised person (not just a well intending neighbour) lets the Priest know.

Ministry to Sick, Aged, Housebound and Hospitalised:

This Pastoral care in our parish is currently being reorganised according to Professional Standards of the Church, and parish protocols are being developed. Sound heavy !!!! But it is what has to be done in our time to comply with standards of care for persons on need and who are vulnerable. Fr Kingsley has undertaken the Project of redeveloping this Pastoral ministry in our parish.

Ministers of Holy Communion and of the Word:

Extra-ordinary ministers of Holy Communion both at Mass and to persons outside of the Eucharistic Assembly on Sundays are very valuable and greatly needed.... Over the next couple of months we will have meetings for training, and introduction of Standards and Protocols, and then Commissioning of the ministers... the same will apply to the Readers at Mass... this is an exciting time for our parish.

Baptism of Infants at St Patrick Catholic Church:

Parents seeking baptism for their children should make an appointment with the Administrator, and attend a preparation session with one of the Priests - a copy of the birth certificate should be made available to the parish office. Sponsors (Godparents) should be over 16 yrs of age - baptised, confirmed, and made their first Holy Communion...one Catholic sponsor is required by the Church at Baptism - there may be two (male and female).
