#### Columbarium

Parishioners have requested that a Columbarium (wall to house the ashes of deceased persons) be constructed in the grounds of the church. It is not a practical option, so after negotiations with Lincoln Grove Memorial Gardens an outcome can now be presented. The proposed granite 56 site Columbarium can be constructed on a site within Lincoln Grove. The quote will be valid for only a limited time and registrations will be accepted on a first in first secured basis and **subject to payment of \$1100.00 fee for this year. The price of the site increases every year.** The parish does not have financial resources to fund construction. *If you are interested you are asked to complete the form in the foyer.* Payment will be required in advance of authorisation to build the Columbarium and at least 75% of the 56 sites will need to be sold to enable the project to proceed. It may not be exclusive to our parish and if sufficient interest is not shown by our parishioners, then the offer will be extended to the other parishes within Tamworth.
