### All Souls Day and November Masses

Join us in the great prayer of the Mass, 2nd November, All Souls' Day. Do not forget this day, do not forget the Holy Souls in Purgatory. Please use the November Masses envelope found at the foyer. The names of your dear dead that are submitted are placed on the book in the sanctuary for all the days of November, and will share in the following: \*A Mass offered for them on 2nd November and \*A remembrance in all Masses offered in our Church during November.

Every year on these eight days the Church grants a plenary indulgence that can be applied only to the souls in purgatory. The faithful can receive this indulgence each of the eight days to apply to a particular soul — a parent, spouse, relative, friend, or anyone even unknown. On each day from Nov. 1-8 a person seeking the plenary indulgence for a soul must 1) devoutly visiting a cemetery and at least mentally praying for the dead; (2) on All Souls' Day devoutly visit a church or an oratory and recite an Our Father, Hail Mary, the Creed devoutly reciting the prayer, "Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen."

#### Requirements for obtaining a plenary indulgence:

- Do the work while in a state of grace,
- Receive Sacramental confession within 20 days of the work (several plenary indulgences may be earned per reception),
- Receive Eucharistic communion (one plenary indulgence may be earned per reception),
- Pray for the pope's intentions (Our Father and Hail Mary, or other appropriate prayer, is sufficient),
- Have no attachment to sin (even venial) – i.e., it is sufficient that the Christian makes an act of the will to love God and despise sin.

#### Sub Tuum Praesidium

We fly to thy patronage, O holy Mother of God; despise not our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us always from all dangers, O glorious and blessed Virgin. Amen

#### Prayer to Saint Michael

Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in the day of battle. Be our safeguard against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him we humbly pray, and do thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Hosts, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who wander through the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.
